

Keep in mind that basic action verbs are usually used in photo descriptions. Think about other verbs similar in meaning to a specific action verb.

Observing objects

- look at [examine, inspect, check] the product
- · look around [browse through] the store

Getting on/off (vehicle)

- get out of [get off, step down from, exit] the vehicle
- · get on [board] the vehicle

Loading things

stack [pile up] the products

In most cases, the subject is the same for all the 4 choices; therefore, it is important to focus on the verb. Also, pay attention to the person's outward appearance.

Making a phone call

- · The woman is talking on the phone.
- · The woman is conducting a phone conversation.
- · The woman is using her cell phone.
- · The woman is holding a receiver to her ear.
- The man is calling from a public phone.

Making a speech

- · The woman is making a speech.
- The woman is giving a lecture.
- She is speaking into a microphone.
- She is presenting at a podium.
- The man is gesturing with his hands.

Working at the desk

- · She is working at a desk.
- She is handling a stack of papers.
- She is sorting through some papers.
- A woman is reading at a cluttered desk.
- He's working with electronic devices.

Dining in a restaurant

- · The man is sipping his drink.
- The woman is holding a kitchen utensil.
- The cook is preparing some food.
- · The man is pouring something into a cup.
- · The chef is stirring something in a pot.
