SOUND DISCRIMINATION 1

• Spellings of Sounds /I/

Spelling of sound /I/: The English vowel /I/ normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter A in the final ATE, AGE:

Ex: intimate, delicate, village, cottage

2. Letter E in the prefixes BE, DE, RE:

Ex: begin, become, decide, return

3. EY:

Ex: money, storey. But: key /ki:/

4. Letter I in words of monosyllable ending with I + CONSONANT
Ex: bit, sit, dim, him, twin

5. UI:

Ex: build, guilt, guitar, equivalent, colloquial

But: mosquito /məskwí: təʊ/

6. Y in an unstressed syllable of a word:

Ex: copy, candy, quality, gravity, slowly

But: qualify /GI/, modify /GI/

• Spellings of Sounds /i:/

The English vowel /i:/ normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter E before the final form: CONSONANT + E

- Ex: be, he, she, me Sc<u>ene</u>, compl<u>ete</u>, Vietnam<u>ese</u>
- 2. EA:

Ex: <u>ea</u>sy, <u>ea</u>st, d<u>ea</u>n, h<u>ea</u>t, n<u>ea</u>t, dr<u>ea</u>m, b<u>ea</u>m, br<u>ea</u>the, cr<u>ea</u>ture

3. EE:

Ex: s<u>ee</u>, fr<u>ee</u>, agr<u>ee</u>, h<u>ee</u>l, scr<u>ee</u>n, ch<u>ee</u>se, guarant<u>ee</u>

4. EI:

Ex: s<u>ei</u>ze, c<u>ei</u>ling, dec<u>ei</u>ve, rec<u>ei</u>ve, rec<u>ei</u>pt

5. Letter I in some words from the French origin

Ex: Machine, regime, mandoline, sardine, routine, magazine, chemise / Jəmi:z/ 6. IE when it is inside vowels of a word:

Ex: grief, chief, believe, belief

SOUND DISCRIMINATION 3

• Spellings of Sounds /e/

The English vowel /e/ normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter E in words of monosyllable ending with one or more consonants (except R), or in a stressed syllable of a word:

Ex: b<u>e</u>d, <u>ge</u>t, <u>me</u>t, th<u>e</u>m, d<u>e</u>bt, <u>se</u>nd, <u>mé</u>mber, Nov<u>é</u>mber, el<u>é</u>ven

But: her, term / 3:/, interpret /Int3':prIt/

2. EA:

Ex: h<u>ea</u>d, br<u>ea</u>d, br<u>ea</u>th, br<u>ea</u>kfast, st<u>ea</u>dy, j<u>ea</u>lous /dʒéləs/, m<u>ea</u>dow, m<u>ea</u>sure, l<u>ea</u>ther, pl<u>ea</u>sure.

3. EI:

Ex: leisure, heifer /héf/: bò nái tơ

4. Special case:

Ex: pallmall /pélmél/, thames /temz/

• Spellings of Sounds /ad/

Spelling of Sound / $_{\infty}$ /: The English vowel / $_{\infty}$ / normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter A in words of monosyllable ending with one or more consonants:

Ex: lad, dam, fan, map, rank, ihanks, catch, thatch Sc<u>ene</u>, compl<u>ete</u>, Vietnam<u>ese</u>

2. Letter A when it is in a stressed syllable of a word having more than one syllable and stands before consonants:

Ex: c<u>a</u>ndle, c<u>a</u>ptain, b<u>a</u>ptize, l<u>a</u>tter /læ'tə/, n<u>a</u>rrow, m<u>a</u>nner, c<u>a</u>lculate

But: stranger /ei/

SOUND DISCRIMINATION 5

• Spellings of Sounds /a:/

The English vowel /a:/ normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter A in words of monosyllable ending with R or R + CONSONANT, or in a syllable of a word when A stands before R + CONSONANT:

Ex: bar, far, star, barn, cart, harm, charm, departure

But: scarce /skeəs/, quart /kwɔ:t/, sparrow /spæ'rəʊ/

2. EU:

Ex: <u>aunt</u>, laugh, draught

3. Special case:

Ex: clerk /kla:k/, derby /da':bI/

Spellings of Sounds In/

The English vowel /N normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter O in words of monosyllable and in the stressed syllable of word having more than one syllable:

- Ex: come, some, done, love, does, other, does, other, among, monkey, mother, brother, honey, nothing, company, through /θΛ'rə/
- 2. OU:
 - Ex: young, rough, touch, tough, enough, contry, couple, double, trouble, cousin/k∧'zn/, nourish /n∧'rI∫/, flourish, southern
- Letter U in the prefixes UN-, UM- and in some common words:
 Ex: cup, gun, skull, uneasy, unable, umbrella
 But: busy /I/, bury /e/, munute /I/

The English vowel /v/ normally appears in the following spelling forms:

1. Letter A in the stressed syllable of words of monosyllable beginning with W:

Ex: was /wpz/, want, wash, watch

But: way, waste, wax /wæks/ (sáp ong)

2. Letter O in words of monosyllable ending with one consonant and in the stressed syllable of words having more than one syllable:

Ex: cod, lot, snob, logic, coffee, doctor, modern, solitary, oppsite
